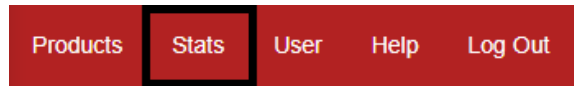


HomeSeer Plug-in Portal

Stats and Release Notes

Here at HomeSeer we have been working hard to improve the plug-in portal. In some recent updates, we have rolled out a couple new features.

The first feature is Stats! This gives the ability for authors to view their current months sales of non-free plug-ins. To view, click on Stats in the main menu. This includes all plug-in sales of any of your plug-in for the given month-to-date. Previous months will not be available.



The second feature is Release Notes!

This feature will allow each released version to have a set of release notes. In the updater, there is a Release Info link on every plug-in.

-Version will show the current release version. In the Links row, there is also a Guide link if you choose to add a separate guide to your plug-in submission.

-Support goes to your sub-forum.

-Release Info now links to a HomeSeer hosted page.

- Ability to support a wide range of mission-related ongoing research and other projects (including sufficient habitable volume and power generation for facilities and operations) without impact on primary mission operations.
- Space allocation for mission-specific facilities: Habitable area to include 800,000 m2 for mission-adaptable facilities including living quarters for mission-specific attached personnel.
- Ability to operate independent of starbase refurbishment for extended periods. Independent exploration mode capability of seven Standard years at nominal Warp 6 velocity for docked configuration. Ability to execute deep-space exploration missions including charting and mapping, first cultural contact scenarios, and full biologic and ecologic studies.

- Secondary (impulse) propulsion system to provide sublight velocities up to and including 0.02 lightspeed (c). Engine systems of choice to include but are not limited to at least two

Release notes work similar to *Features* and *Requirements*. The version will be taken from the current text in your *Version* text field. Date is the date of the push to the updater. Notes can be removed and added until the update is pushed to the updater. Once an update is completed, release notes will be locked and cannot be edited. Each version should have relative notes on what is fixed, what is new, and what has changed. See below for an example of what an Added note looks like.

The form is identical to the previous one, but the table now contains one entry. The 'Note' column has 'Release Notes 1', the 'Version' column has '3.0.1.5', and the 'Date' column has '8/7/2018 2:36:51 PM'. A 'Remove' button is located to the right of the table.

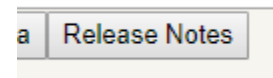
